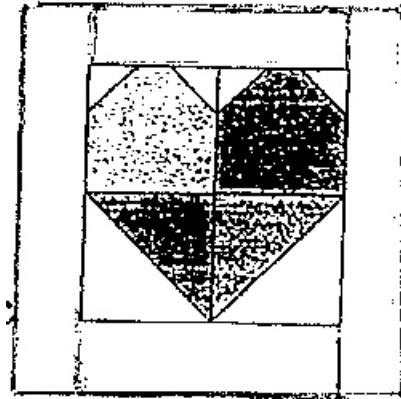
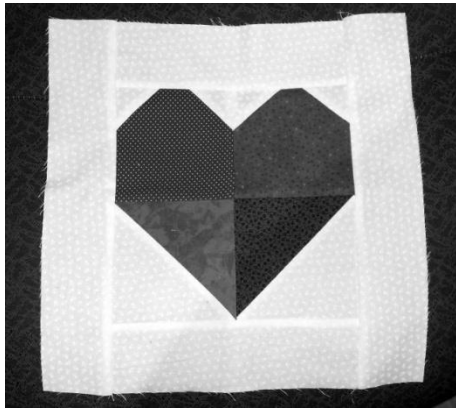

Happy Hearts



Guild provides:

Red: two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, two triangles (already cut diagonally from $4\frac{7}{8}$ " squares, in case you want to make more of these at home)

YOU provide:

White:

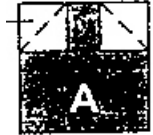
-Two 2×4 " rectangles, cut into four 2 " squares

-one $4\frac{7}{8}$ " square, cut diagonally,  to make two white triangles

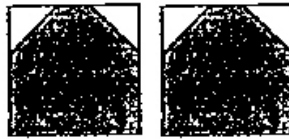
-two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for framing border

-two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strip for framing border

Sew small white squares as shown to each upper corner of red square (snowball), press toward outside corner and trim away the back



layer of the triangle, do this twice:

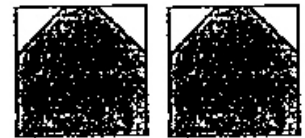


Sew red triangle to white triangle as shown, do this twice:

Press to red triangle



Sew two upper heart pieces together, press seam open,

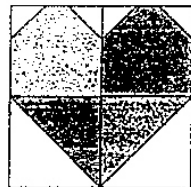


Sew two lower heart pieces together, press seam open.

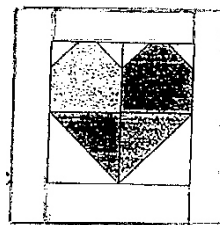
Sew upper section together, to

and lower section

make heart block:



Sew 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips to top and bottom of block, then sew 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips to each side to frame block:



Your block should measure 12 1/2" when sewn together
