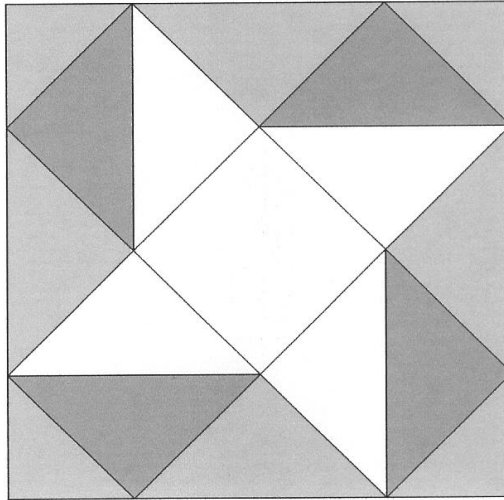

“Quilt Takes Patriotic Hues” - 12 ½” Block



You provide: **White or white-on-white** fabric

Cut **two** 3 7/8” white squares, cut each in ½ diagonally for four outer corners:



Cut **one** 7 ¼” square, cut diagonally both ways to make 4 triangles as shown:



Guild provides:

Red: -cut **one** 7 ¼” square, cut diagonally both ways to make 4 triangles, as you did with white.

-cut **one** 4 ¾” square for center of block

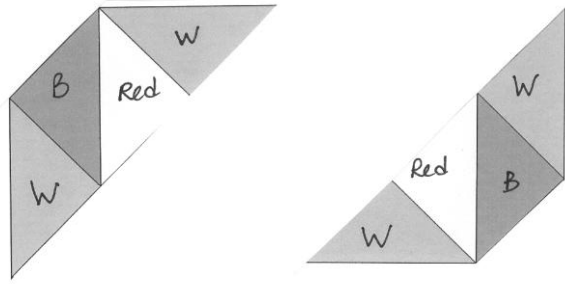
Blue: -cut **one** 7 ¼” square, cut diagonally both ways to make 4 triangles, as done for white and red above.

Sew order:

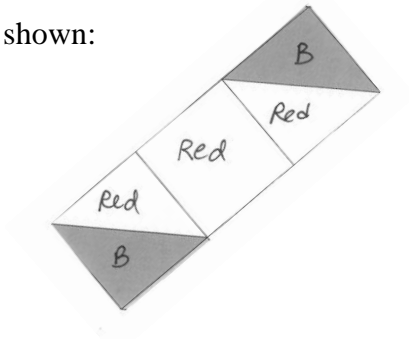
Sew red and blue triangles together to make four 4 ¾” squares:



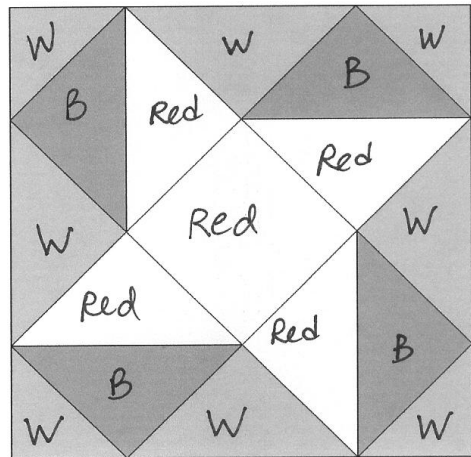
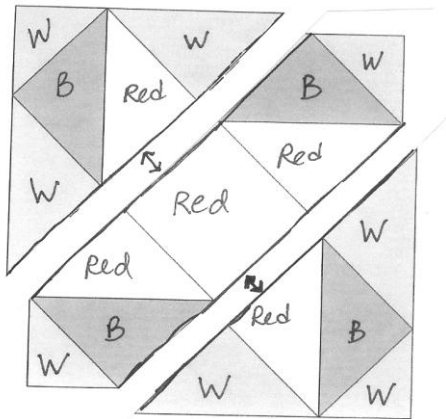
Sew **large** white triangles to each side of red/blue squares as shown:



Sew red/blue triangles to each side of red center square as shown:



Sew small white triangles to ends of middle section, and to remaining corners. Sew sections together as shown:



Block should be 12 1/2" to turn in.
