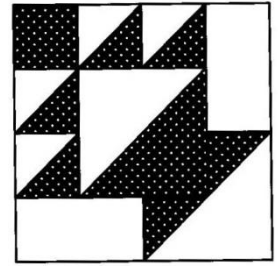


BLOCK OF THE MONTH
July 2013

NAME: Candy Dish

SIZE: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished



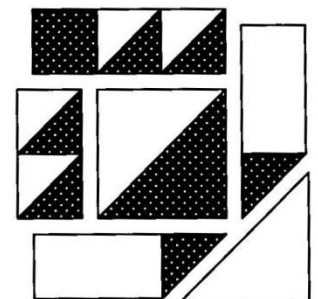
Fabric A: printed fabric provided by CCQG (**NOTE:** This piece is not cut to size so you will need to cut per directions below)

Fabric B: solid black fabric provided by you; this should be quilt shop quality fabric

FOR	CUT	MEASURE	NEED	
Fabric A:	1	4 7/8 " square	1 half triangle	
	3	2 7/8" squares	6 half triangles	
	1	2 1/2 " square		
Fabric B:	1	4 7/8 " square	1 half triangle	
	2	2 1/2 x 4 1/2 " rectangles		
	2	2 7/8" squares	4 half triangles	

NOTE: You will have half of a 4 7/8 " square of Fabric A left over.

1. Sew two of the small half triangles of Fabric A to the rectangles of Fabric B.
2. Sew the large half triangle of Fabric A to the large half triangle of Fabric B.
3. Sew the remaining small half triangles of Fabric A to the remaining small half triangles of Fabric B. Press toward Fabric A.
4. Lay out your block as shown. Sew the small square to two small half triangle units. Sew the remaining two small triangle units together. Pay close attention to directionality.
5. Sew the two small triangle units to the large triangle unit. Sew the square/triangle unit to this unit.
6. Sew the rectangle/triangle units to each side.
7. Sew the large half triangle of Fabric B to complete the block.
