

July Pinwheel Star

Finished size: 6" block

Materials needed:

Cream fabric, assorted red and blue prints (or colors of your choice) in the following dimensions:

Cream fabric

Cut **4** 3-1/2" squares for background fabric

Assorted Reds

Cut **2** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for star points

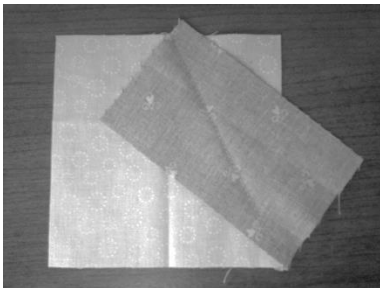
Assorted Blues

Cut **2** 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for star points

Assembly:

Fold each cream square in half and lightly press center to use as guide for placement of rectangles.

Place one rectangle on top of one background square, right sides together. Line up the bottom left corner of rectangle to bottom right corner of the square. Note the upper right corner of the rectangle should lie just above the background fabric. Stitch from the middle of the square down by lining up the needle where the two fabrics meet and sewing down to the bottom right corner. See example below.

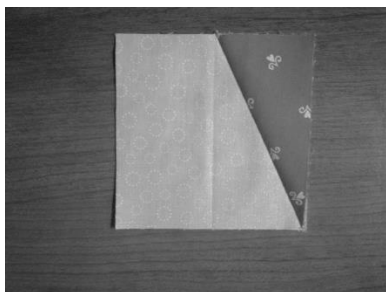


Fold the rectangle back to insure the corners line up.

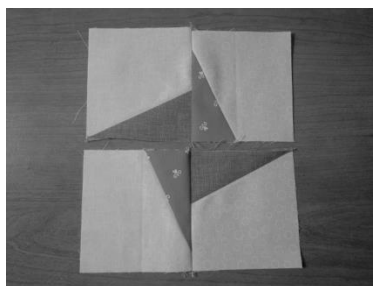
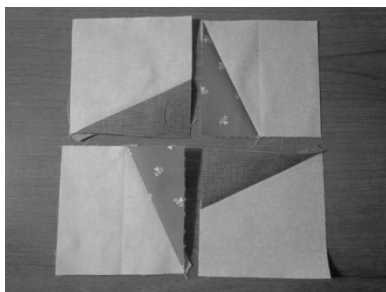


Place a ruler on sewn line – leaving a ¼” seam allowance and cut off excess background and rectangle fabrics. Trim away points.

Press fabric away from the background fabric.



Make 4 (2 red and 2 blue). Sew two blocks together.



Sew the four blocks together as shown below.
