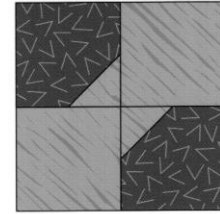


BLOCK OF THE MONTH

June 2013



NAME: Bow Tie

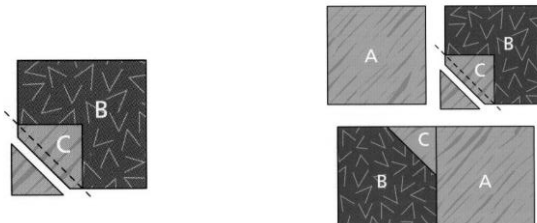
SIZE: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished

COLORS: Two fabrics are used for this block:


A and C: printed fabric of your choice (**NOTE:** A and C are the same fabric; this should be quilt shop quality fabric)

B: Muslin with gold dots provided by CCQG (**NOTE:** This piece is not cut to size so you will need to cut per directions below)

FOR	CUT	MEASURE	NEED
A	2	4-1/2" x 4-1/2"	2
C	2	2-1/2" x 2-1/2"	2
B	2	4-1/2" x 4-1/2"	2



MAKE SURE YOU LAY OUT YOUR BLOCK BEFORE YOU BEGIN SEWING.

1. Draw a diagonal pencil line across each Square C. This is your stitching line. 
2. Align Square C in one corner of Square B and stitch on the stitching line.
3. Repeat for the second Square B.
4. Trim the outer corners leaving a 1/4 inch seam allowance (see diagram). Press toward Square B.
5. Sew Square A to the B/C square taking care to position each square unit correctly. Press toward Square A.
6. Sew the two A/B/C units to each other.
