

June Log Cabin Star

Finished size: 12" block

Materials needed:

Paper-backed fusible web (like Lite Steam-A-Seam 2), paper scissors, cream fabric, assorted red and blue prints (or colors of your choice) in the following dimensions:

Cream fabric

(A) Cut 1 6-1/2" square for background fabric

Assorted Reds

(B) Cut 1 2" x 6-1/2" strip

(C) Cut 1 2" x 8" strip

(D) Cut 1 2" x 9-1/2" strip

(E) Cut 1 2" x 11" strip

Assorted Blues

(C) Cut 1 2" x 8" strip

(D) Cut 1 2" x 9-1/2" strip

(E) Cut 1 2" x 11" strip

(F) Cut 1 2" x 12-1/2" strip

(G) 1 6" x 6" square for star

Assembly:

Log Cabin

First round

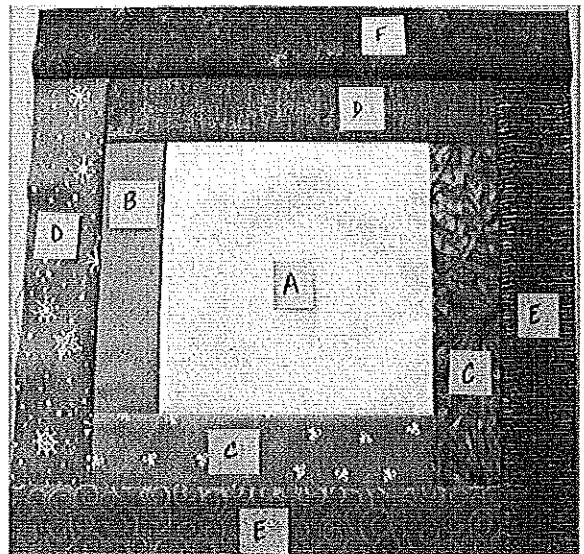
Sew red (B) strip to left side of background square.
Press seam away from background square.

Note: With both rounds, after each strip is sewed on, press seam away from the background square.
Sew red (C) strip to bottom of background square.
Sew blue (C) strip to right side of background square.

Sew blue (D) strip to top of background square.

Second round

Sew red (D) strip to left side of square
Sew red (E) strip to bottom of square
Sew blue (E) strip to right side of square
Sew blue (F) strip to top of square



Star

Follow manufacturer's instructions for using fusible web.

Trace star pattern below onto correct side of fusible web paper.

Cut out traced piece of the fusible web paper – being careful to cut about a $\frac{1}{4}$ " allowance around traced lines.

Peel and stick fusible web to blue star fabric as noted above and cut fabric out following the traced lines. Place star on center of background fabric. Fuse star in place.
