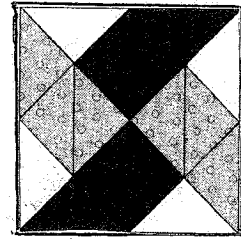








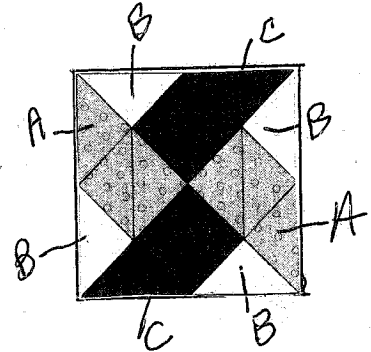
BLOCK OF THE MONTH 2013

MONTH: March
 NAME: Twin Sisters
 SIZE: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished



COLORS: 3 A=Polka Dots B=Black C=Butterfly

FOR	CUT	MEASURE	NEED
A	2 	5-1/4" x 5-1/4"	6 
B	1 	5-1/4" x 5-1/4"	4 
C	2 	5-1/4" x 5-1/4"	6 

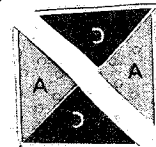


NOTE: You will have 2 A triangles and 2 C triangles left over that will not be part of this block.

MAKE SURE YOU LAY OUT YOUR BLOCK BEFORE YOU BEGIN SEWING

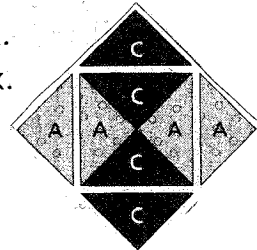
1. Create the center of the block by sewing the 2 pieced *opposing* triangles together.

1. To make the 2 pieced triangles sew together 1 single triangle A to 1 single triangle C. Do this twice making sure they are *opposing* each other.



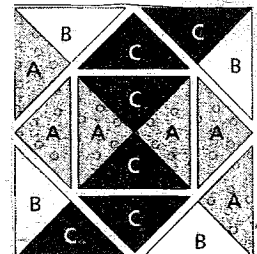
2. Add 4 single triangles to create a new larger block as follows:

1. Sew 1 single C triangle to each C on the center block.
2. Sew 1 single A triangle to each A on the center block.



3. Add 4 pieced triangles to create the final block as follows:

1. Sew together 1 single triangle A to 1 single triangle B. Do this twice making sure they are *opposing* each other
2. Sew together 1 single triangle C to 1 single triangle B. Do this twice making sure they are *opposing* each other
3. When sewing pieced triangles to block make sure the A side of the pieced triangle matches up with the A triangle on the block.
4. When sewing pieced triangles to block make sure the C side of the pieced triangle matches up with the C triangle on the block.
