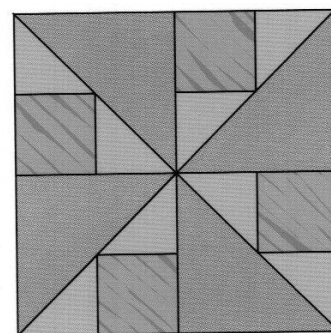


## BLOCK OF THE MONTH May 2013



NAME: Whirlwind

SIZE: 10 1/4" x 10 1/4" unfinished



COLORS: 3:

**A: YOU HAVE A CHOICE FROM YOUR FABRIC STASH OF ONE**

**OF THE FOLLOWING SOLID COLORS:** A medium value pink, a medium value orange, a medium value purple, a light or medium value yellow, or a light or medium value green. This fabric should be quilt shop quality fabric.

B: marbled blue fabric provided by CCQG – measure and cut to size needed

C: variegated fabric provided by CCQG – measure and cut to size needed

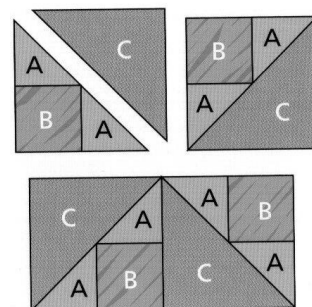
FOR	CUT	MEASURE	NEED
A Your choice	4	3-3/8" squares	8 triangles, cut diagonally 
B Marbled blue	4	3" squares	4 squares
C Variegated	2	5-7/8" squares	4 half triangles, cut diagonally 

MAKE SURE YOU LAY OUT YOUR BLOCK BEFORE YOU BEGIN SEWING.

1. Sew one triangle A to the edge of square B as shown above. Press seam to the square. Sew a second triangle A to the adjacent side of square B; press toward the triangle. Repeat with all the small triangles and squares.

2. Sew an A/B/A unit to a triangle C creating a square unit. If you sew with the A/B/A unit on top you can better judge where the point of the square will be. Repeat for all triangle C's. Press seams to large triangle.

3. Sew two A/B/A-C units together; press seams open. Repeat. Then sew the two units together; press seams open.
