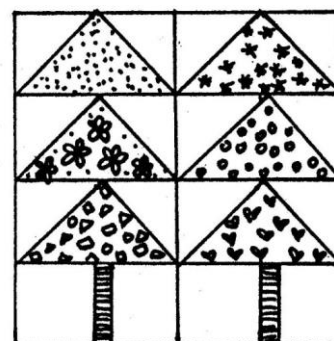
NAME: Holiday Trees

SIZE: 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" unfinished

Background Fabric provided by CCQG

Six Assorted Green Fabrics: From your stash; vary the colors, prints, textures (this should be quilt shop quality fabric)

Brown Tree Trunk Fabric: From your stash

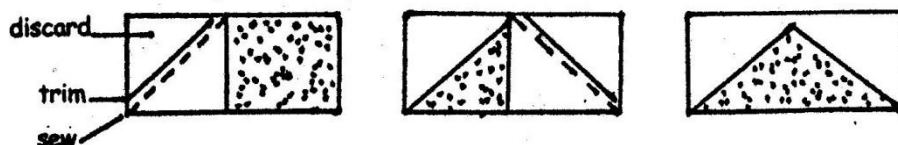


FOR	CUT	MEASURE	NEED
Background Fabric :	12	2 3/4" squares	12 squares
	2	2 1/2 x 3" rectangles	2 rectangles

Six Assorted Green Fabrics: Each fabric cut into a 5" x 2 3/4" rectangle

Brown Tree Trunk Fabric: 2 1" x 3" strip

1. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on the 12 background squares.
2. Place a background square on the left side of a green print rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the line and discard the cut away triangles. (See below.)
3. Place another background square on the right side of the green print rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the line and discard the cut away triangles. (See below.)
4. Repeat for the remaining five green rectangles.
5. Sew a 2 1/2" x 3" background piece to a brown strip, matching the 3" side of the brown strip to the 3 inch side of the background fabric. Sew the other background piece to the other side of the trunk. Do this one more time.
6. Sew the block together into horizontal rows. Then sew the horizontal rows together to complete the block.
