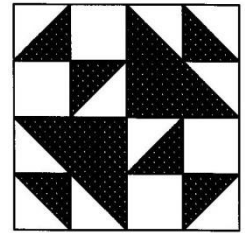


BLOCK OF THE MONTH October 2013



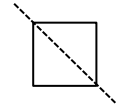
NAME: School Girl's Puzzle

SIZE: 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished

Fabric A: black fabric provided by CCQG

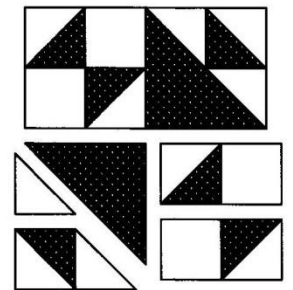
Fabric B: White on white print provided by you; this should be quilt shop quality fabric

FOR	CUT	MEASURE	NEED
Fabric A:	1	4 7/8 " square	2 half triangles
	3	2 7/8 " squares	6 half triangles
Fabric B:	5	2 7/8 " squares	10 half triangles
	4	2 1/2 " squares	4 squares



MAKE SURE YOU LAY OUT YOUR BLOCK BEFORE YOU BEGIN SEWING.

1. Sew all the small black half triangles to a small white half triangle. You will have six sets.
2. Sew two white triangles to a black/white unit per diagram. Repeat a second time.
3. Sew the unit created in Step 2 to one of the large black half triangles. Repeat.
4. Sew a white square to a black/white unit created in Step 1. Repeat 4 times.
5. Sew the square/triangles units together per diagram.
6. Sew a square triangle unit to a large black triangle unit creating a strip. Repeat.
7. Sew the two strips together.
