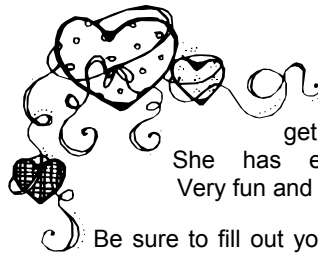

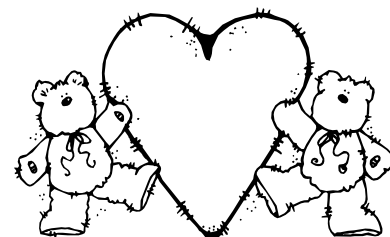
I also want to thank everyone for their flexibility in coming to the January meeting on a Friday night. I thought Sue's quilts were stunning, and the class



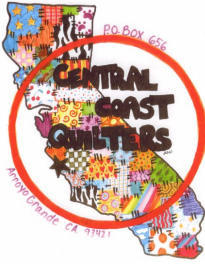

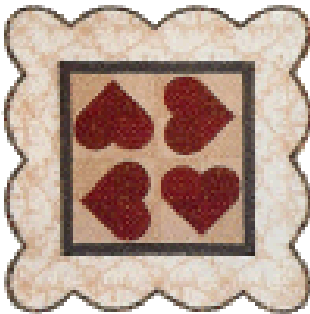
